Hello Pink class!

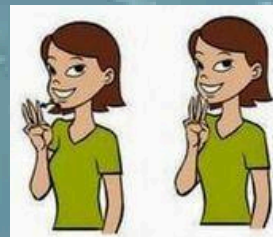

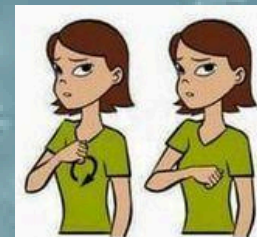
